#### Phantom Flyers RC Club Meeting Minutes - 16 March 2020

The March club meeting was considered non-essential and canceled in consideration of the coronavirus.

Looks like we have an extended build season, which is the way that I look at.

RCGroups has a thread in the Scale kit/Scratch Built section called, Quarantine Scale Build-Off! The originator has done these types of build off contest for some years. This one is to make use of the 'shelter in place' that many of us, worldwide, are experiencing now.

The rules are simple and he only has 3.

Rule 1. Build-Off entries must be models of real aircraft (or of designs of aircraft that were proposed to be built), ie. "scale" models. "Sport scale" models will be just fine.

Rule 2. Build-Off entries must not have been the subject of a previous build log. Models that are already under way are fine, as long as they don't already have a build log.

Rule 3. The Build-Off Director (me ) gets to settle any urgent issues not covered by Rules 1 and 2.

Since none of us wants to be quarantined forever, the Build-Off will run until July 1st, 2020, but we'll probably need a second wave of quarantine so that'll take us to September 1st. Who knows, maybe we'll need a third wave too...

I haven't submitted my intent to build because I am limited on the supplies I have here at the house. However, I do have a couple of projects in mind. The McDonnell Douglas F3H Demon or the Douglas D-588-1 Skystreak.


The F3H Demon would be large, about 73 inches in length and powered by a 90mm EDF unit. The Skystreak would be powered by a 70mm EDF unit and about 44" long.

Truth be told the Skystreak is an easier build and the size is based on my largest hole saw (5") I have in my tool box. But it has its share of hurdles, not a whole lot of wing area to haul 6S pack, retracts and that super long ducting.

The bulk of CAD work for the F3H has been done for some time. The Skystreak will be done by the TLAR (That Looks About Right) method.
