PHANTOM FLYERS 2 METER RUDDER/ELEVATOR SAILPLANE CONTEST #13 August 1, 2015 (Harold Weaver)

Twelve flyers (see results in chart below, significant scores are shown in red) enjoyed a nearly perfect day with almost no wind and fairly good lift especially during Round 5 where almost everyone found some. The days winners were Kevin Cox (Aspire), Ed White (Radian EP), and Brian Molloy (Radian EP), with 1464, 1310, and 1258 pts respectively. Al Bone (Radian EP) was close behind in 4th with 1241 pts. Two of the lowest scoring Rounds were deleted for each person however the results were identical if all Rounds had been used except Jan Jansen would have moved ahead of Jeff Brandt.

There were a couple rule changes for the contest: EP gliders were required to launch in the same direction as the High Start launches until motor cut off. EP Gliders that have to restart their motors to avoid landing too far out from the field, time will stop at the time of motor re start and will receive minus 50 landing pts.

Don Grzina did a nice lawn dart landing with his CANARROW Canard during an aborted launch in Round 1 due to a control problem but was able to fly all the rest of the Rounds.

The new Spirit glider acquired from Bob Gill and donated to the club by Larry Anderson had a few problems with the wing attachment. The [aft] wing bolt plate broke loose on launch. Ed White noticed a gap on the trailing edge just as Jim Alberico called out trouble and said he didn't have elevator, the glider started heading for the ground and just before he would have impacted he regained elevator authority. The glider just kissed the ground then went back in the air. It gained about 50' of altitude then came off the hi-start. Jim was able to nurse it back over the corn then landed it in the grass next to the runway. Ed repaired it with super glue then Jim flew it again.

There were 1 Aspire, 2 Spirit, 1 Super Easy EP, 2 Vistas, 4 Radian EP's, 1 Vista EP, and 1 CANARROW Canard gliders entered. Harold Weaver Vista Contest CD
