#### Secretary's Report

The May, 2015 Meeting Minutes were approved. Club membership is at 47 regular members

#### **Treasurers Report**

The Treasurer reported our current balance and dispersed funds for Club expenses.

### **Safety Discussion**

There was a glider landing close to the Pavilion. And gilder flying across the road was discussed.

#### **Field Managers Report**

We are approaching the end of the 30 day waiting period for sealing runway cracks.

Runway sealing was discussed

- Need load rating of trailer tires
- Talked about scheduling the sealing in September or October
- Don G. said he would get driveway sealer for the cracks

Pavilion roof repair was discussed

- There is a concern that the weather is getting hot
- Need to budget \$1,200 \$1,300 for the repair
- Need a drip edge to prevent wind damage
- A motion was made and approved to spend not more than \$900 on roofing material
- A motion was made and approved to spend an extra \$400 on labor to install the roof

The field was rolled and it seems to have made a difference. The roller has gotten stuck in low wet spots in the field. In cases where you stuck, there is a cable on the wall of the tractor house. Use it and secure it with a padlock. You need two people to pull a stuck lawn mower out of the mud.

The white plastic chair was broken and needs to be thrown away. It was found in the middle of the bean field after a windy night.
