
Elfrink Lake Float Fly June 29, 10:00 – 1:00







The Flood of 2019!

Thanks to talented and resourceful club members we have glimpses of how our field has faired with the raising water. The aerial recon team was James Greenwood and Jose with the Mavik drone.

I actually made 2 flights, as I got lost on the first one and had trouble finding the field. I was bucking a 7+ mph headwind, so it took forever to get there. Very nerve racking! I was hoping to hover right over the field and scoot around for 5 minutes down low, but as I got to within 1000ft, both times, my battery (and my gut) told me to hit return to home. Even with the wind, it took an agonizingly long time to get it back to dry land. Much thanks to Jose for helping out and spotting for me. Very fun flights, but very sad for all the people directly affected by the flooding. It's unbelievable.






Bill Ahrens captured another set of pictures from an undisclosed airship and that was passed on to Ed White for photo analysis.

Here are the pics I promised. I'm not going to bet my house on this, but here is my best guess. In the pic along the MS river in the distance you can pick out what I am pretty sure is the Portage Des Sioux power plant. Using that landmark and the course of the MO river I drew the red line on the image from Google Earth in slide 2. The red line is where the camera was when it took the picture, though I can't say for sure where on the red line since I only have that one line and no other cross line. The yellow lines are the approximate right and left sides of the FOV. The yellow push pin is the location of the flying field.

Back to the picture on slide 3, the red box area is where I will zoom in on. In the zoomed image in slide 4, the MO river is clear. The line of trees going off at an angle is the Katy Trail (the bump you go over when leaving our field to the SE). If that is correct, and I apply what in amateur astronomy is termed averted imagination, I think I see a few pixels representing the container and the pavilion.
