You can wear a mask if you want, but I will not make it mandatory.








The 3 sections of the fuselage are temporarily glued together and the hatch has been cut out for the FMS 80mm EDF unit. The forward section, from the nose to the rear of the canopy, will have a 1/64th thick ply liner for the battery area support. This was because to get the 6S battery to fit will require removal of all the foam the in that area.

I did a mock-up with a vertical fin and found out my drawings didn't match up to the photos of the actual aircraft. I had to fudge a few things but it looks closer to scale. A canopy was also carved out of foam and will be used as a plug for vacuum forming later.

I also used Fusion 360 CAD to design a tail cone so my 3D printer could do the work and I could brush up on my weak 3D CAD skills.





5 hours later the part is done! The weight is a hefty 1.6 oz so depending on CG balance needs I may use it for a plug for vacuum-forming.

Below is the mock-up. The new vertical and its spine needs more shape tweaking as well as the canopy. The tail cone is just taped on for appearance. It is a fairly long model!



2020 Mowing schedule is now available!

Please find attached the mowing schedule for this year. It covers June to mid October. Mower contact information is included on a second page. Please print and save the schedule for future reference. A copy of the schedule will be posted on the club web site. We have 16 mowing volunteers this year. Teams of three mean there is a new round of mowing after five sessions. I set the schedule by assigning random numbers to each name, sorting by the random number, and inserting three names in order for each week. I repeated the sequence four times to cover the remaining mowing season.

I have delayed posting a schedule for a couple of reasons. First, the Covid-19 health crisis caused the field to be closed for some time. So let me remind everyone to maintain safe health practice while at the field. However, if we can't keep three mowers six feet apart on six acres, we have real problems.

Second, the field suffered some vandalism over the winter leaving some vehicle tracks in the grassy areas off each end of the runway, and nearer the road off the south end of the parking area. I would advise mowing these areas by following the track on a tangent to the ruts; This is far more comfortable than mowing across the ruts. It is not the most efficient method, but is easier on the back side. If anyone finds mowing these areas too uncomfortable, feel free to let me know and I will cut the damaged areas at the next opportunity.

The red Zero-Turn mower has been equipped with a fuel cutoff valve to prevent flooding and hard starting of the engine. I have posted some photos in the storage shed showing the valve located near the left rear wheel. Please remember to close the valve once the mower is parked back in the shed.

I want to take this opportunity to remind mowers to check engine oil level before mowing. The proper method is to remove the dipstick, wipe it dry, then reinsert it back into the fill tube without screwing the dipstick down. Oil level within the hatched area of the dipstick is within limits.

As field manager, I want to thank each of you for volunteering. Please contact me with any issues relative to the equipment.
