# Safety Officer (and Carrier Wave Editor) Cautions Against Accidents Such As These



Landing near water can be especially difficult. It seems that the water is detrimental to depth perception.

Landing an airliner in a lake can be particularly embarrassing.



Check for foreign objects on the runway very carefully.

Do not exceed cross wing landing capability of your aircraft. More importantly, don't exceed the limits of the pilot.





Landing short on the a runway under construction is not recommended. Two wrongs rarely make a right when it comes to landing an aircraft.



Be most careful not to park your aircraft in an area where it might be damaged by another aircraft operated by a careless pilot.

If you are the careless pilot mentioned above, it is good form to admit your mistake. Don't bother to make up an excuse, no one will believe it anyway...



It is generally not a good idea to run up the engines with the propellers in reverse pitch. OK, I couldn't think of any other way one could get an airplane in this position.



Perform a landing gear check *before* lining up on the runway.

Have a safe and enjoyable flying season. Hopefully, this winter will soon give way to pleasant temperatures and mild breezes.

Be aware of and secure loose objects close to your engines *before* you start the engine.
