

Quarantine Project Douglas D-588-1


I selected and started my project, Douglas D-588-1. It will be constructed out of foam (blue), I would have preferred to use the lighter white foam but I will save that for another project.


Since I used blue foam it will be a heavier bird and while a 70mm on 6S should fly it, an 80mm fan on 6S will be better. I traced the 3-view drawing into AutoCAD to allow me to measure and scale as needed. After this I decided to settle on a size of 52" long with a span of 37".



The design of the fuselage is broken into 3 main sections. The forward section includes the nose to mid-way to the canopy, about 9". This will have to be shaped by carving and putting it into my vertical lathe (drill press) for fine tuning. The 2nd section is just a 27" cylinder shape and will be hotwire in a form of top and bottom halves.

The 3^{rd} section is conical like and it will be cut like the 2^{nd} section be with 3 different templates and is about 17.75" long.

Poster board template for section 1 (nose). I modified my Dremel scroll saw to be a hotwire jigsaw. A series of 2" thick disk will be stacked and glued together. Once together, I can start the fun part, making blue dust.





With the initial hand sanding done time to temporarily glue ends on to mount it to the drill press for more sanding. The center, for ducting will have to be removed. I haven't decided if I will cut it in half or drill a starter hole for the hotwire.







Section 2 (cylinder) cut and rolled over the intake duct cut and removed. The process is fairly quick but it will slow when I get to the final sanding and finishing.

For the finish, I have a few methods that I use to finish foam models,

The first is to sheet the foam in 1/32" balsa and then glass it with 34" glass cloth or iron-on film.

Another method is to cover it with brown paper (Kraft) and mixture of Elmer's Carpenter Glue and water. I could, if wanted to, cover with ¾" glass cloth for additional strength.

The last option is to use 1.5 oz glass cloth.

The wings will be covered in balsa for sure and glassed afterwards.

Hopefully some of you found this interesting.
