The meeting was called to order at 7:02 pm by the Club President, Ed White. There were 13 members in attendance and no new members. The meeting was held at Mark Twain Hobby Shop.

Secretary's Report

Previous Meeting Minutes were approved. Don Grzina and Bill Haines reported that they did not receive the Carrier Wave.

Field Manager's Report

- Don reported that the locks have all been lubricated and are functioning well.
- We will still have to cut the grass 1 to 2 more times before the year's end.
- It was reported that we are short of oil for the mowers. It was further identified that the green mower is low on oil and there is a spot of oil under the mower. Don Albert suggested that the filter may be leaking as it has in the past.
- Runway sealing was discussed. It is too late to do it this season and we will have to do so in the spring. Don Albert suggested that we may need new tires on the trailer to support the 2,800 pound tote, that the current tires are probably not rated for that kind of load. The trailer may also need new plates. Renting a trailer for the sealing job was suggested instead of replacing tires and licensing costs. Also considered was getting rid of the trailer and storing it in the container now that we have a good locking system.
- It was suggested that the latrine needs to be painted in the spring. Don Grzina said it would be pumped out one more time this year.
- We are waiting for member Jack Buydos to get back to the club on shingles for the roof. It is too late in the year to shingle the roof this year.
