- The X-Mark mower has flooding problems. Don suspects there is a shut off valve problem. Turning the tank selector switch off was discussed as a potential solution.

I need to get rid of some stuff in order to make space in the shop and raise some money for next years pattern plane. I will be putting some things on eBay but I wanted to see if any of you are interested first.

Kits (does anybody do that anymore?)

- 1. Morris Mustang, 40 sized fun fly profile airplane, gear wheels and tank included (not part of original kit): \$40
- 2. Delight Special, formula 1 racer (scale?), fiberglass fuse, foam wings, originally prize \$124.95 at Schaefer's: \$40
- 3. Small glider, Wind Weasel II, 1.5m, fiberglass fuselage pod, balsa-spruce wing: \$20
- 4. Drifter II/Easy Breezy, 2m wood glider. Box includes plans for both. However probably parts for just one: \$15
- 5. Great Planes Flatouts Extra 330s, all flat surface electric foamy: \$15

Engines (All of these were purchased used before I turned to electric. I have not run any of these engines myself!)

- 1. YS F-91AC with standard muffler and tuned pipe. Used \$120
- 2. Gas 25cc(?), no brand noted, weed-waker style. Looks clean but I assume used: \$10
- 3. Supertigre 90. Used but good: \$50
- 4. Supertigre 3000S, monster nitro two stroke with engine mount and factory Pitts style muffler: \$70

#### Airplanes

- 1. Organic 2m full house (aileron and flaps) Vee tail glider. High end carbon fiber glider from Kennedy Composite. Ready for flight with all servos and Spectrum carbon fuse receiver. \$ 350 (current list price for glider is \$749)
- 2. Small 25 size pylon racer airframe only: \$10
- 3. Drifter II (??) 2m wood glider. Complete but needs TLC \$10
- 4. Seagull 2000 by Seagull Models, flown only a handful of times. Fast aileron and elevator. With motor and folding prop. I should be able to find speed controller. Just not the kind of glider I like to fly: \$120.
- 5. Mini Bee, fast delta wing ducted fan jet. profile fuselage. 30" wingspan. Ready to fly with Spektrum receiver. Have old batteries. Not flown for a while. \$40
- 6. Balsa USA Phaeton II Biplane. Used airframe only wings are Monokote covered. Fuselage needs covering. Fiberglass cowling. 60 two stroke or 90 four stoke required (not included) \$40
- 7. Swift 40 ARF. Racer style 40-52 2-stroke size. Good construction. Nice white and blue with checkered trim. Covering still tight after many years in box. Painted white cowl a bit yellowed. Was going to convert to electric. Large box, probably hard to sell on eBay. Only \$50.

We were successful in launching large gliders. John intends to join the club at the November meeting and we will have winch launch glider capability next year. At the November club meeting I will give a tech session on glider winches and retrievers.
