I finally finished my F-107 model. Enough for test flying anyway. Got thru the first flight, so now I can start adding airplane bling (nose booms, centerline tank, adtnl detail, etc). That will take a



while. Here are some pics!

No ailerons on this beasty. The model uses a spoilerslot-deflector system, just fwd of where ailerons would normally be. I flew with 88 oz of burnable fuel, for a 5 min flight. I've now added another 16 oz – the turbine is thirsty.
